

A trip to Loviisa to the wooden idyll of the city of the Queen

We will discover the history of the city on a guided walking tour around the fortress area and the old town and by visiting the Town Museum.

History and today meet on the streets and alleys of the old town. The annual Historic Houses of Loviisa event is a must for many restorers and builders. The event is the highlight of the end of the summer. Then you can go and visit the restored houses on your own and discover the stories of life at the renovation process including the glories and the miseries of renovation.

The wooden houses consist of beautiful boutiques and Bistro Kronan serving incredibly tasty food. There is a tiny cake shop in the courtyard next to Bistro Kronan and nearby a cosy restaurant Degerby Gille by the same entrepreneur. The restaurant invites you to enjoy the cosy interior of a riding stable built in 1695.

Two things to do in the old town: climb up to the Myllyharju to observation tower at Kukkumäki and walk down to the Laivasilta Service Marina.
